Form 1 – General Cell information Census of Prison Population 14 January 2014.

Form 1 includes information on the numbers of usable cells in each institution, the number of cells that accommodated one, two, three and four or more prisoners. The form also asked how many prisoners had to slop out or had to use toilet facilities in the presence of others.

The key statistics from the Form 1 General Information are:

- There were **3973** prisoners in custody
- There were **3,172** usable cells in the prison system
- **1,854** prisoners were accommodated in single cells (47% of all prisoners (3,973) were in single cell accommodation)
- 809 cells accommodated 2 prisoners (1618 prisoners)
- **121** cells accommodated 3 prisoners (363 prisoners)
- **36** cells accommodated 4 or more prisoners (138 prisoners)
- 465 prisoners (11.7%) were required to slop out
- **1628** prisoners (40.9%) were required to use the toilet in the presence of another prisoner
- **1880** (47.3%) prisoners were in a single cell with a flush toilet or had access to toilet facilities in private at all times.
